## **College of Nurses of Ontario seeking that facility be named in the Susan Muzylowsky decision**

The College of Nurses of Ontario will be asking a discipline panel to remove the publication ban on the name of the facility where Susan Muzylowsky worked as a nurse. At Muzylowsky's May 16 hearing the discipline panel ordered a publication and broadcasting ban of the name of the facility where the nurse worked, the identity of clients and any information which could identify clients.

Upon reflection, the College has decided this request was overly cautious. The client identities are sufficiently protected with a publication ban which prohibits any information that could identify clients. The College will be preparing a written submission asking the panel to reconsider the publication ban and delete the reference to the facility name. The College is asking the panel to consider the issue promptly.

The College has notified the facility of its intention to seek a reconsideration and the facility does not object.

It is important to note the publication ban on the facility name remains in effect until the panel decides to remove it. The College will announce the panel's decision on **[www.cno.org](http://www.cno.org)**.
