Supervised Practice Experience Program (SPEP) Employer Checklist



THE STANDARD OF CARE.

The checklist outlines the organization's responsibilities when participating in SPEP.

Become an approved organization

- Organizations interested in participating in SPEP must complete and submit the <u>Supervised Practice</u>
 <u>Experience Partnership form</u>
 - Organizations must submit one form per site.
 - CNO confirms SPEP participation approval by email.
 - Once a site is SPEP approved, organizations are not required to resubmit a partnership form.

Matching with SPEP eligible applicants

Match with SPEP eligible applicants:

- Ontario Health will match eligible applicants with approved acute care facilities, long-term care homes, home health and community care organizations.
- Retirement homes must self-match with SPEP eligible applicants.

Confirm applicant SPEP eligibility

• Employers must verify the applicant received an eligibility message from CNO (see below). The SPEP placement must match the category (RN or RPN) noted in the eligibility message.

Please note this opportunity pertains to you and confirms your eligibility in the program. Only individuals who are eligible receive this message. You will be required to provide proof of receiving this message to Ontario Health and/or your employer before you can begin the program.
